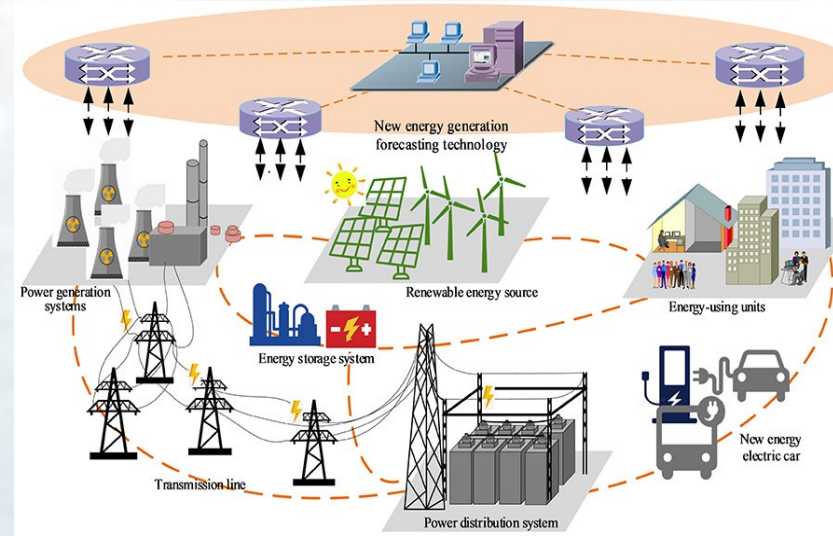

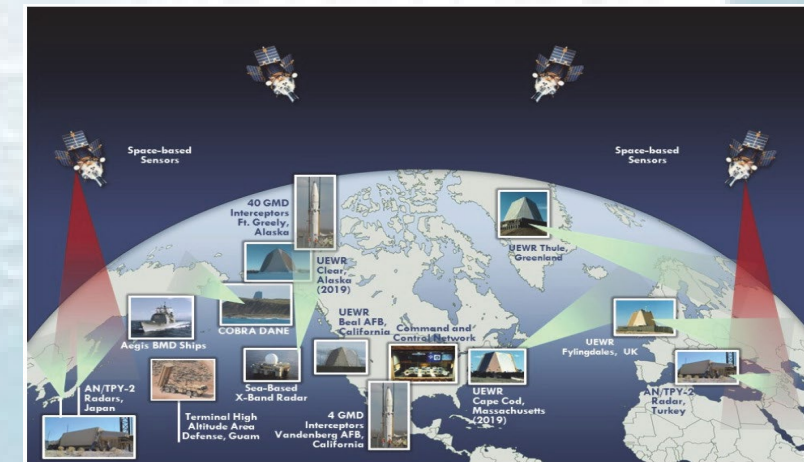

Integrated Implementation Approaches

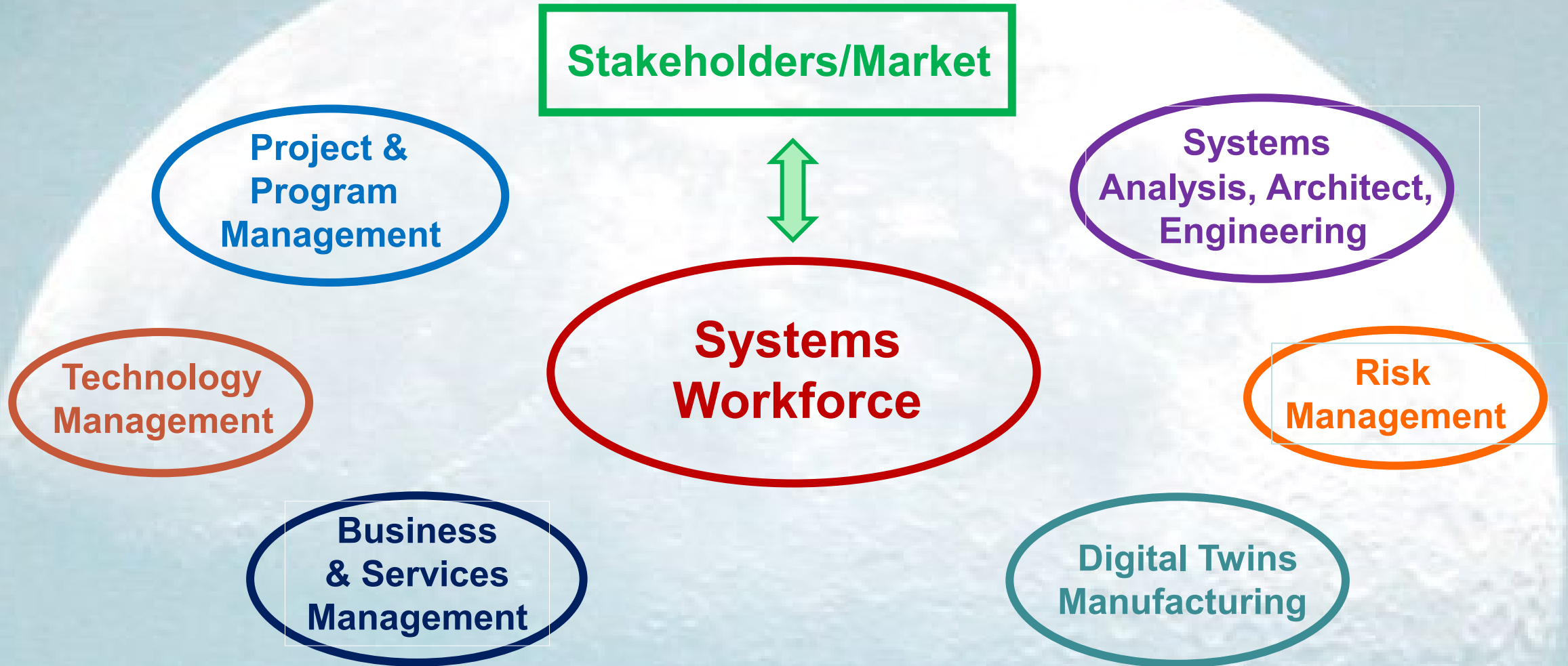
- to realize trusted, AI supported system concepts and designs with hardware, software, and service elements and seamless interoperability characteristics

- to ensure successful realization of all system elements for OEM integrators & suppliers

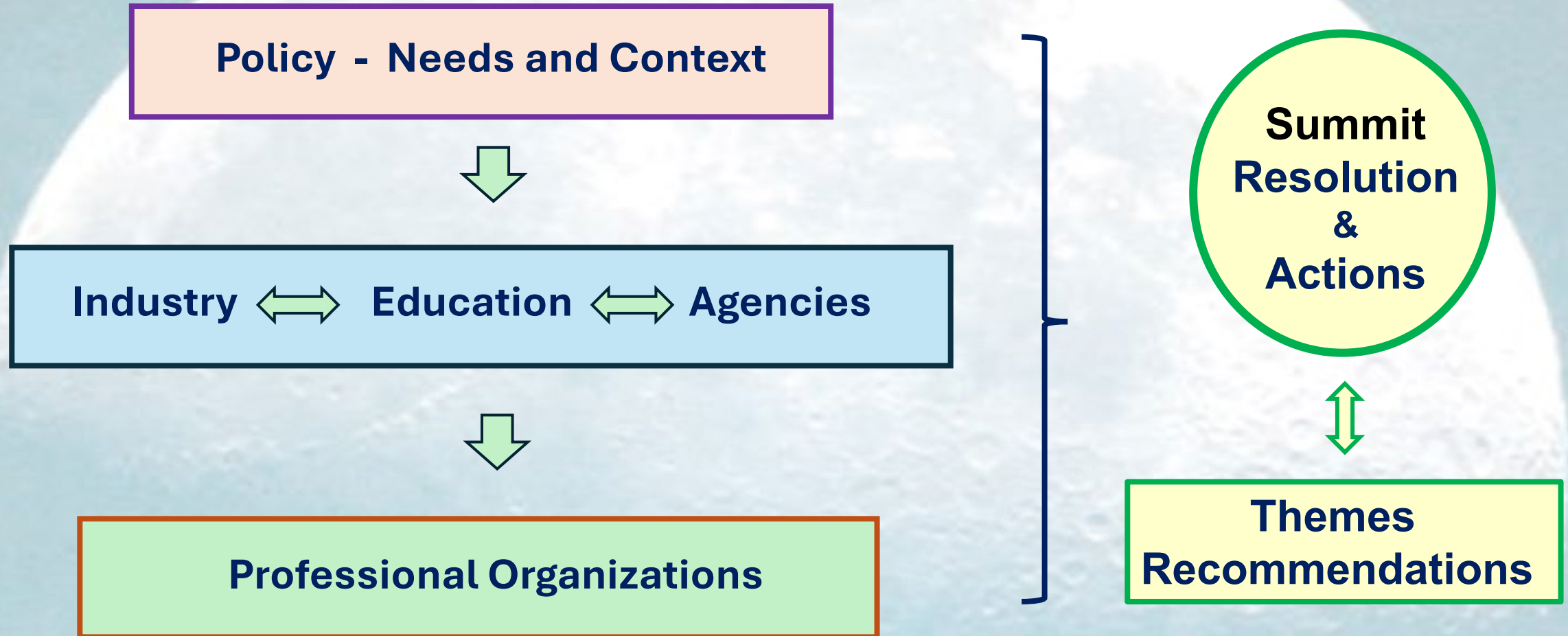
Pragmatic System Realization Teams

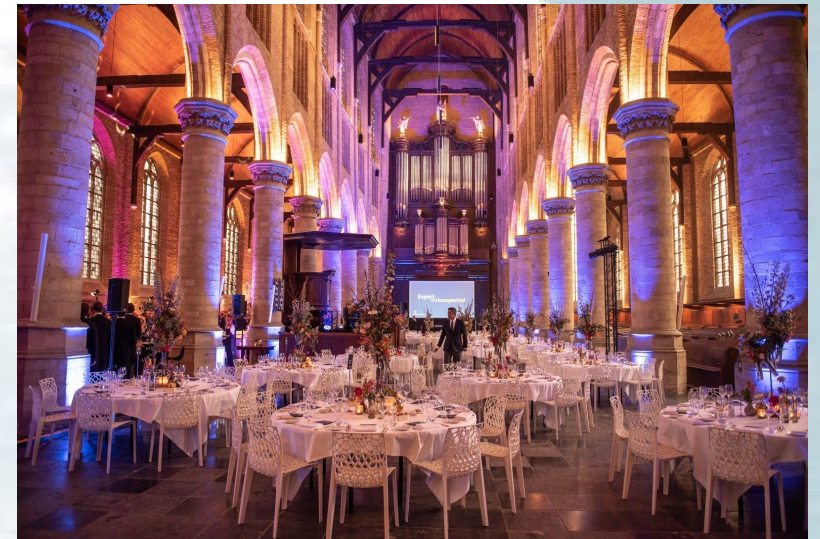
